

Preparing to come back into school

How will you get to and from school?

If at all possible, come to school by walking or cycling. If you do need to use public transport remember that the buses and trains are not as frequent as they were before, and that you will need to wear a face mask. There are restrictions on the numbers of people who can board a train or a bus, so your journey may take longer than it used to.



Remember, if you come to school on the bus you will need to wear a face mask and maintain social distancing while you travel.


What will you wear to school?



You do **not** need to wear your school uniform. You should come in to school in clean clothes and should change out of them as soon as you get home.

What will you need to bring?

- **Equipment.** Please bring a bag with your own pencil case and pens in it. This will avoid you needing to borrow any equipment. You should make sure that you have wiped all of your pens and equipment clean before coming in to school.
- **Food and drink.** Bring your own drink and your own water bottle. You can fill this up at one of the water fountains in the school. Bring a small snack if you want as well – the canteen will **not** be open for service.
- **Lockers**
Lockers will **not** be in use for this period of time.




What time do we start?

Different students will have different arrival times in order to allow us to manage social distancing. Make sure you know what time you are expected to arrive at school.




What happens in school?



- When you come in to school you will need to wash your hands immediately and go to the room that you have been assigned for the session.
- Listen carefully to the instructions you are given so that you know exactly what is expected of you.
- In order to manage social distancing and to keep you and the other students and staff safe, it is really important that you pay good attention to instructions and to signs and notices around the school. You must maintain 2m of social distancing at all times. There will be no need for you to wear a face mask or any PPE.
- If you are unable to manage social distancing, you may find that you will be sent home.

What happens if I can't come to school?



If you have been invited in to school for a session, you are expected to attend unless you are unwell or have a reason not to come in (for example if you are shielding a member of your family or if you yourself needs to be kept shielded). Please let us know in the usual way if this is the case, as we will need to complete the registers with the correct information.

If you are at all unwell you should **not** be in school. Do not come to school if you are not feeling well. If, whilst at school, you feel unwell, you should tell a member of staff immediately and arrangements will be made for you to go home.



If you are sent home unwell, you must begin a period of self-isolation.
